

SYSTEM CHANGEOVER TECHNIQUES

Method	Description	Pros	Cons	Visual
Abrupt Changeover	Switches to the new system on a single cut-off date and immediately stops using the old system	- Fast and simple - Low cost	- High risk - Little/no fallback	
Phased Changeover	Replaces the old system in planned stages, introducing the new system module-by-module	- Easy to test - Identify problems early	- Takes longer - Can be complex	
Parallel Changeover	Runs the old and new systems at the same time until there is confidence in the new system	- Low risk - Fallback to old system	- More expensive - Extra resources

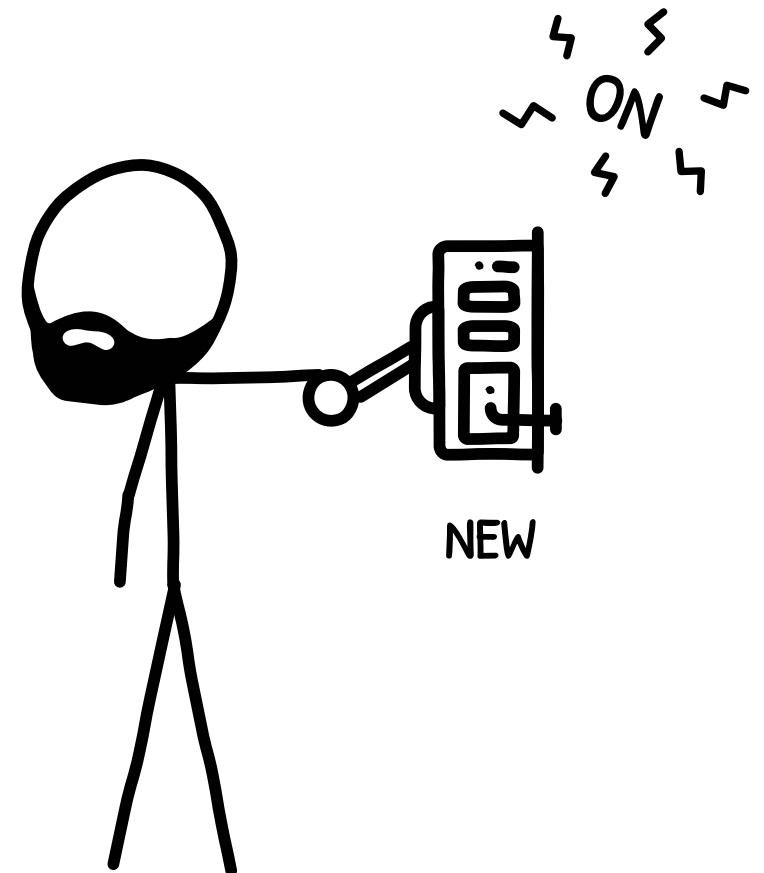
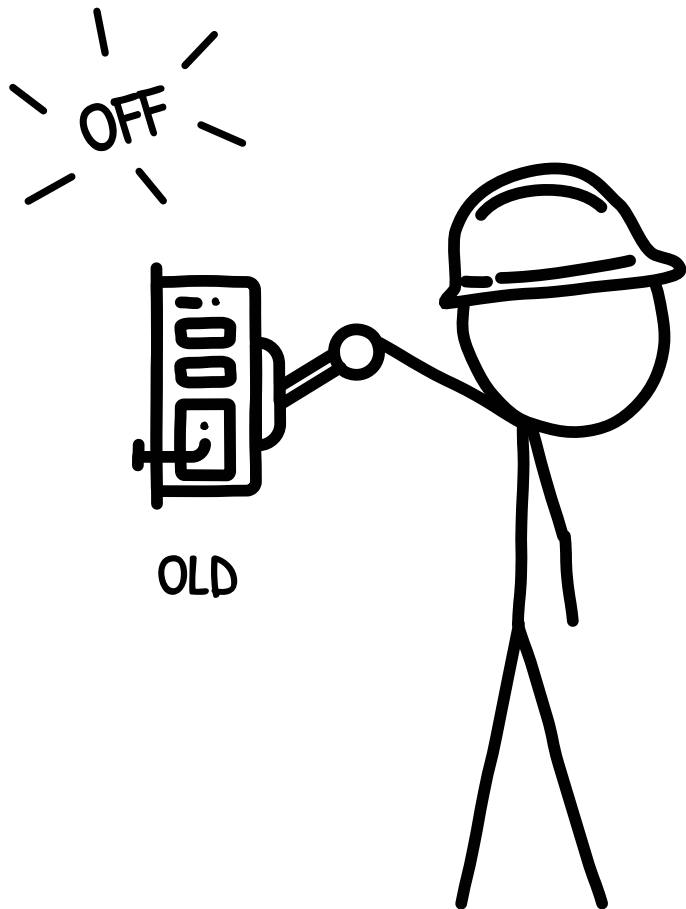


New System

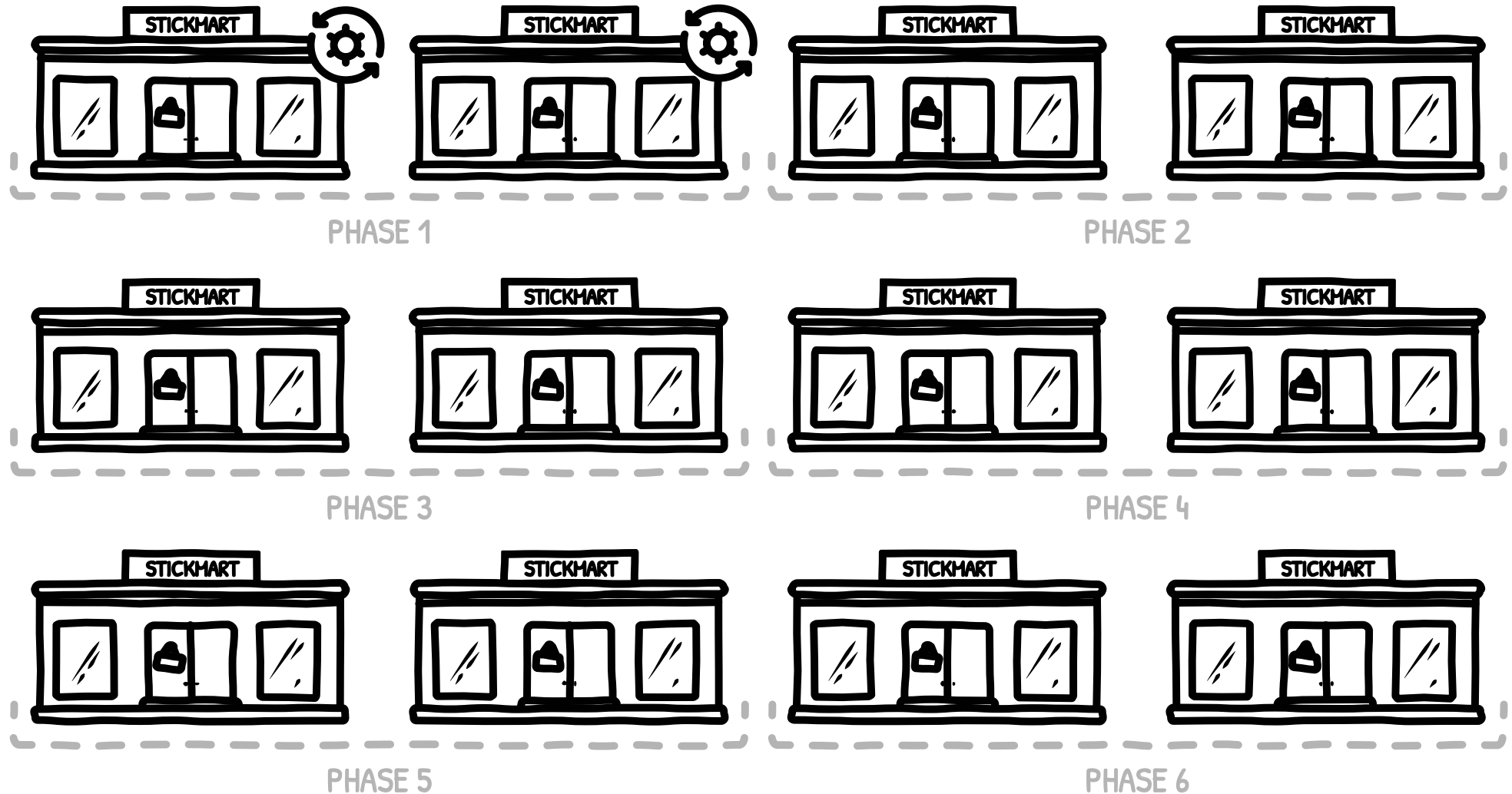


Changeover Complete

ABRUPT CHANGEOVER

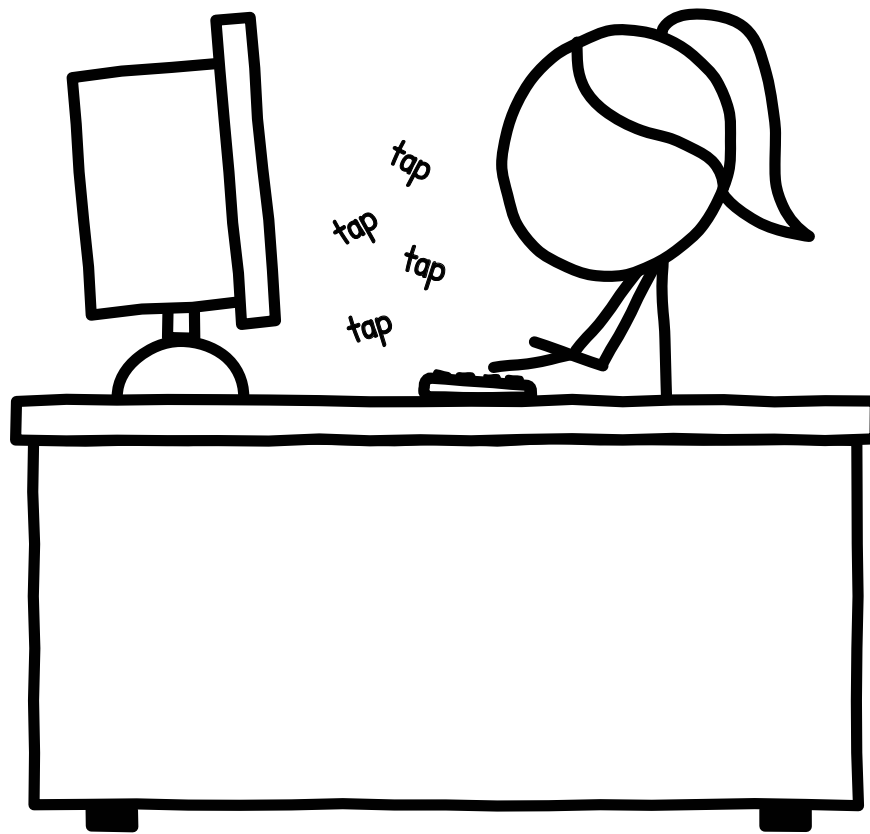


PHASED CHANGEOVER
